He serves on the Advisory Board of Calvert Hall College and started the Lasalle Program for college bound students with learning disabilities and serves as a Life Trustee of Jemicy School.

Jim has been inducted into the University of Baltimore's Athletic Hall of Fame and Calvert Hall's Hall of Fame. He has received a Bachelor of Science in business administration from the University of Baltimore and received the University of Baltimore's Entrepreneur of the Year Award. Jim enjoys the game of golf. He and his wife Bernice have four children and ten grandchildren and reside in Lutherville, Maryland.
